

Town of West Sweden- Monthly Meeting
May 15, 2018

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Simon Nelson by at 6:32 pm. Present were Supervisors: Scott Wilder and Glenn Meier; Phyllis Wilder, clerk; Brenda Tesch, treasurer; Kevin Taylor, patrolman; Ken Ruhn, resident; Todd Roehm from Lakeland Communications.

The April meeting minutes were presented by the clerk. No corrections or additions needed, minutes stand approved as presented.

The financial statement for April was presented by the treasurer. The board thanked her for the report. Board approved moving new business first on the agenda.

Unfinished Business:

- A. Salt sand building property: Nothing to report.
- B. Road Inspection Report: Scott provided written report. Will bring back to June meeting.
- C. Adopt revised ATV ordinance: Phyllis reported that the Trade Lake township met with opposition to opening all roads to ATV's. Simon N made the motion to table ordinance revision at this time, Glenn 2nd, motion carried.

New Business:

- A. **Lakeland Communications:** Todd Roehm reported that Lakeland is interested in laying cable in West Sweden and explained the process to the board. The Town would need to provide a letter of intent to Lakeland Communications, become a Broadband Forward community by adopting an ordinance and sign a Partnership agreement. No cost is incurred on the part of West Sweden. Glenn M made the motion to support the project, Scott W 2nd, motion carried.

Employee report: Kevin reported that the International truck has been at Meyer's since last Thursday. Pickup running rough, took in for oil change at Auto Quality and received a quote of \$1100 for additional repairs. Recommended to get another estimate. Kevin will be gone Saturday until Sunday afternoon. Get confirmation of coverage of warranty on International. Highway Commissioner from Burnett County stated he would help write Trip D project for road work from 35 to 345th on 150th Street, timeline would be 2020 for work to be done.

Ambulance Report: Glenn reported they have hired second full-time assistant manager and the new ambulance is here. Village of Luck is now looking at Northland or Lakes.
