Wayne Swenson presented the subdivision of Buck stop LLC consisting of 30 acres that Calvin Hochstetler is going to purchase. Motion to approve subdivision of property was made by Glenn M, Scott W 2nd, carried.

 - A. **Approve liquor license:** Clerk presented licenses for The Ridge and Skol Haus for review, Glenn M made the motion to grant the licenses to The Ridge and Skol Haus, Scott W2nd, carried,

Employee report: Kevin reported the culvert is exposed (4 ft) and rusted on Bloom Lake Rd, has filled it with gravel and flagged the road. Tom Hengst, Grace Lutheran church council member requested a load of gravel in the cemetery road at Grace Lutheran Church, they are willing to pay for half. The truck repair estimate was to replace engine with rebuilt, board decided to will keep running truck for now. Citizens' have approached Kevin with concerns that should be brought to a board meeting such as fire sign replacement and land use of neighbors.

Ambulance Report: Glenn reported that they received the grant for \$45,000. Municipality's must give notice by June 30 if they will be opting out at the end of December from Northland Ambulance services.
