Employee report: Kevin took Paul Luedtke around to show him where we want trees trimmed, they will start after Thanksgiving. Talked with owner on Omega Farms about beaver problems and still having problems with beavers on 140th Street. Beavers are problems on 180th, 140th, 360th Ave and 325th Ave, town will be entering into contract in 2019 with the USDA for beaver removal.

Ambulance Meeting Report: Glenn reported that it was voted on going to a 3-year agreement with the municipalities. Have 5 new first responders and have people taking classes. December meeting will have draft on new contract for review.
